Board of Directors Eligibility (as per Bylaws)

The Board of Directors shall be comprised of a minimum of five (5) to a maximum of eleven (11) Directors. The Directors shall perform the duties prescribed by the Bylaws.

1. Each member of the Board shall be an Active or Inactive Member in Good Standing, a resident of Canada, and shall not have been found to have committed professional misconduct by the Association.
2. The Chair shall be an Active Member in Good Standing who has served at least one (1) year on the Board within the immediate previous four (4) years.
3. No member of the Board shall hold more than one elected or appointed position within the Association at any time.
4. The Immediate Past Chair, if willing to serve, shall serve for one (1) year as a voting member of the Board of Directors with all rights and responsibilities of a Director.
5. The Association Senior Staff Officer shall be an ex officio, non-voting member of the Board of Directors.
6. The Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary/Treasurer shall be the Officers of the Association.
